

TEMATHANE 50

DESCRIPTION

A two component, semigloss polyurethane paint, hardener aliphatic isocyanate.

PRODUCT FEATURES AND RECOMMENDED USES

- Recommended to be used as a semigloss topcoat for epoxy and polyurethane systems exposed to weathering.
- Excellent weathering and abrasion resistance.
- A durable, easy to clean and non-chalking topcoat with good gloss and colour retention.
- Recommended for painting of outside of storage tanks, steel buildings and other steelwork.

Practical coverage depends on the application method, painting conditions and the shape and roughness of the surface to be coated.

Drying and recoating times are related to the film thickness, temperature, the relative humidity of the air and ventilation.

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APPLICATION DETAILS

Surface preparation Primed surfaces: Oil, grease, salt and dirt are removed from the surface by appropriate

means. Repair any damage to the primer coat. Note the overcoating time of primer.

Primer TEMACOAT GPL-S PRIMER, TEMACOAT GPL-S MIO, TEMACOAT GF PRIMER,

TEMACOAT HB PRIMER, TEMACOAT RM 40, TEMACOAT SPA, TEMABOND, TEMADUR 20, TEMADUR PRIMER, TEMAPRIME GF, FONTECOAT EP PRIMER

and FONTECRYL 10.

Finish TEMATHANE and TEMADUR.

Application conditions All surfaces must be dry. The temperature of the ambient air, surface or paint should

not fall below + 5 °C during application or drying. Relative humidity should not exceed 80 %. The surface temperature of the steel should remain at least 3 °C above the dew

point.

Mixing components First stir base and hardener separately. The correct proportions of base and hardener

must be mixed thoroughly before use. Use Temaspeed Squirrel Mixer for mixing.

Application By airless or conventional spray or by brush. In order to obtain an even, non-porous

finish, spray a misty coat: first a thin layer, then let the solvents evaporate for

5 - 30 minutes and then apply the full coat. Depending on the application method and the temperature of the components (base, hardener, thinner) the paint can be thinned 10 - 25 %. The viscosity should be 30 - 60 s DIN4. Airless spray nozzle tip 0.011" - 0.015" and nozzle pressure 120 - 160 bar. Spray angle shall be chosen according to

the shape of the object.

At conventional spray the viscosity should be 20 - 25 s DIN4.

At brush application the paint should be thinned according to the circumstancies.

Thinner Thinner 1048 or 1067. Thinner 1061 is also suitable for conventional spraying.

Cleaning of equipment Thinner 1048, 1067 or 1061.

VOC The Volatile Organic Compounds amount is 425 g/litre of paint mixture.

VOC content of the paint mixture (thinned 25 % by volume) is 521 g/l.
